#### The Audience

- Good communication starts with knowing your audience
- Jury
- No connection to mental health issues
- My job to make them understand the level of impairment
- Not the clinical diagnosis

# Dysthymia??

- Not eating/binge eating
- Not sleeping/sleeping too much
- Fatigue
- Low self-esteem
- Cognitive impairments
- Feeling hopeless

### Tell a Story

#### Use an Effective Case Theme

- Easy to understand
- Memorable
- Motivational
- Contrast Before and After
- This is a case about...

## If it doesn't fit . . .



### Only the beginning . .

- No matter how good the theme
- Without evidence it is merely a catchphrase

### Use Lay Witnesses

- For the Jury
- For the Experts
- At mediation
- At Trial
- Need to show impairment not just a diagnosis

#### Experts?

- Psychiatrists and Neuropsychistrists
- Will give substance to the theme
- Something for the Jury to rationalize it
- Gives the Jury a medical reason to buy into your theme

#### Experts?

- Identify and measure cognitive functioning
- Memory
- Speed of information processing
- Distractibility
- Executive functioning (plan, evaluate and execute goals...)
- Sophisticated, normed and validated testing
- Validity testing

### The Advantages?

- Effort
- Cognitive Impairment
- Brain v Non-brain injury
- Causation
- Ability to work
- Ability to engage in ADL
- Treatment Recommendations
- Attendant Care

#### The ADL Situational Assessment

- An evaluation of situation functioning
- Task not test oriented
- Measures impairment in a real world setting

#### The Situational Assessment

- Community Outing
- Meal Preparation
- Kitchen Cleaning
- Valpar Work Sample (Problem Solving)
- Taking Phone Calls
- Outbound Phone Calls
- Personal Budget Task
- Cleaning Tasks
- Physical Screening Assessment

#### The Advantages

- Does not rely upon interpreting nauseatingly boring test results
- Real world feel
- Easy to understand

# The Disadvantage

Cannot assess effort
